INSTRUCTION 2401

Special Education

The District shall provide instruction and training for students age three through twenty-one (3-21) whose disabilities are so great as to require special education services in order to develop to their fullest capacity.

Exceptional child is defined to mean those children who are physically disabled, mentally disabled, emotionally disturbed, chronically ill, or who have perceptual impairment, visual, auditory disabilities or speech impairment as well as those children who are so academically talented that they need special education programs to achieve their fullest potential.
