Guidelines for 2020-21 Sporting Events

The Cascade School District (#422)) has put in place protective measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, JSD #422 cannot guarantee that you or your child(ren) will not become infected with COVID-19. Further, attending activities on the campuses of Cascade High School could increase your risk and your child's risk of contracting COVID-19. All visitors voluntarily assume the risk that they may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending activities on Cascade Schools Campuses.

Protective Guidelines:

- 1. Cascade High School is considered a wellness facility. In the event that any person, including: athletes, coaches, fans or support staff is feeling ill or has a fever, they should not attend any events hosted at CHS.
- 2. Cascade Schools will do a simple health screening of all players and coaches, including temperature checks, before arriving at opponents' facilities. Individuals displaying any symptoms will not attend. Visiting Teams are expected to do the same.
- 3. ALL VISITORS/SPECTATORS will have temperature checked upon entering our facilities. Spectators are not allowed at this time for events or practices--only team personnel.
- **4.** Opposing teams will send rosters and essential personnel lists at least 48 hours in advance. **No other personnel will be permitted to enter the facilities.**
- 5. <u>Masks are required by Valley County Mandate (08/10/20 until further notice)</u>. <u>Players and coaches may remove masks during game play, but should be wearing them at all other times.</u>
- 6. Locker rooms (or a pre-game room) will be available for each team. Home and Visiting Teams will not share a locker room. We encourage all players to come dressed for the game.
- 7. Visiting and Home Essential Personnel should not sit together while watching the game.
- 8. Student athletes will provide their own hydration source. CHS will not provide any hydration.
- 9. Hand sanitizer will be provided at various convenient locations for teams and essential personnel.
- 10. All essential and non-essential personnel are expected to maintain and follow all social distancing guidelines. Capacity may be limited in order to maintain appropriate social distancing. Teams should leave the building ASAP.
- 11. Coaches and Support Staff will sanitize equipment as frequently as necessary. Our facilities are kept to the highest standards of cleanliness for the safety of all competitors.

Cascade High School Athletics will continue to monitor the COVID-19 pandemic and modify all plans and guidelines based on the State of Idaho's Rebound plan and the IHSAA and NFHS guidelines.
